RULE 305 - CONDITIONS COVERING AWARDS

(For scores of 300, 299, 298 & 800 Series)

The following are the requirements which must be met for eligibility for Tenpin Bowling New Zealand Inc ("TBNZ") High Score Awards.

1. The high scores must have been bowled in a league or tournament sanctioned by the TBNZ.
2. The lanes upon which the score was bowled must have been certified by the TBNZ for the current season prior to the bowling of the high score game.
3. A competent foul judge or an automatic foul detecting device approved by the TBNZ must have been employed during the full time the score was being bowled.
4. Every provision of the TBNZ Constitution, rules and regulations must have been in effect by those conducting the league or tournament in which the high score was bowled.
5. Notification of the High Score must be given to the TBNZ Centre Representative within 24 hours after it has been bowled. This notification must be given by the League or Tournament Secretary.
6. No more than fourteen (14) days may elapse before the Centre Management or the duly authorised representative gives such notification to the Administration Manager of the TBNZ.
7. Inspection of pins and bowling balls:
8. The Centre Management or the duly authorised representative must inspect and weigh the very pins used when the high score was bowled.
9. These pins should be set aside in a receptacle immediately after conclusion of the score or series in the presence of two opposing team captains awaiting their inspection and weighing by the Centre Management or the duly authorised representative.
10. Any bowling balls used when the high game was achieved shall be certified for correct weight and balance by an authorised person, e.g. Centre Management or the authorised representative, or qualified bowling centre staff member.
11. The inspection and weighing must be done within 72 hours after the score has been rolled. The Centre Management or the authorised representative must complete their report or affidavit to the TBNZ setting forth their recommendation for approval or rejection of the claim. The report, together with the original score sheet, must reach the office of the TBNZ before fourteen (14) days have elapsed.
12. When claims for recognition of individual high games of 300, 299, 298 and 800 series are submitted, the Administration Manager of the TBNZ may approve the issuance of the award immediately upon request of the evidence and affidavits required, or the Administration Manager may refer claims to the TBNZ Management Team for their consideration.
